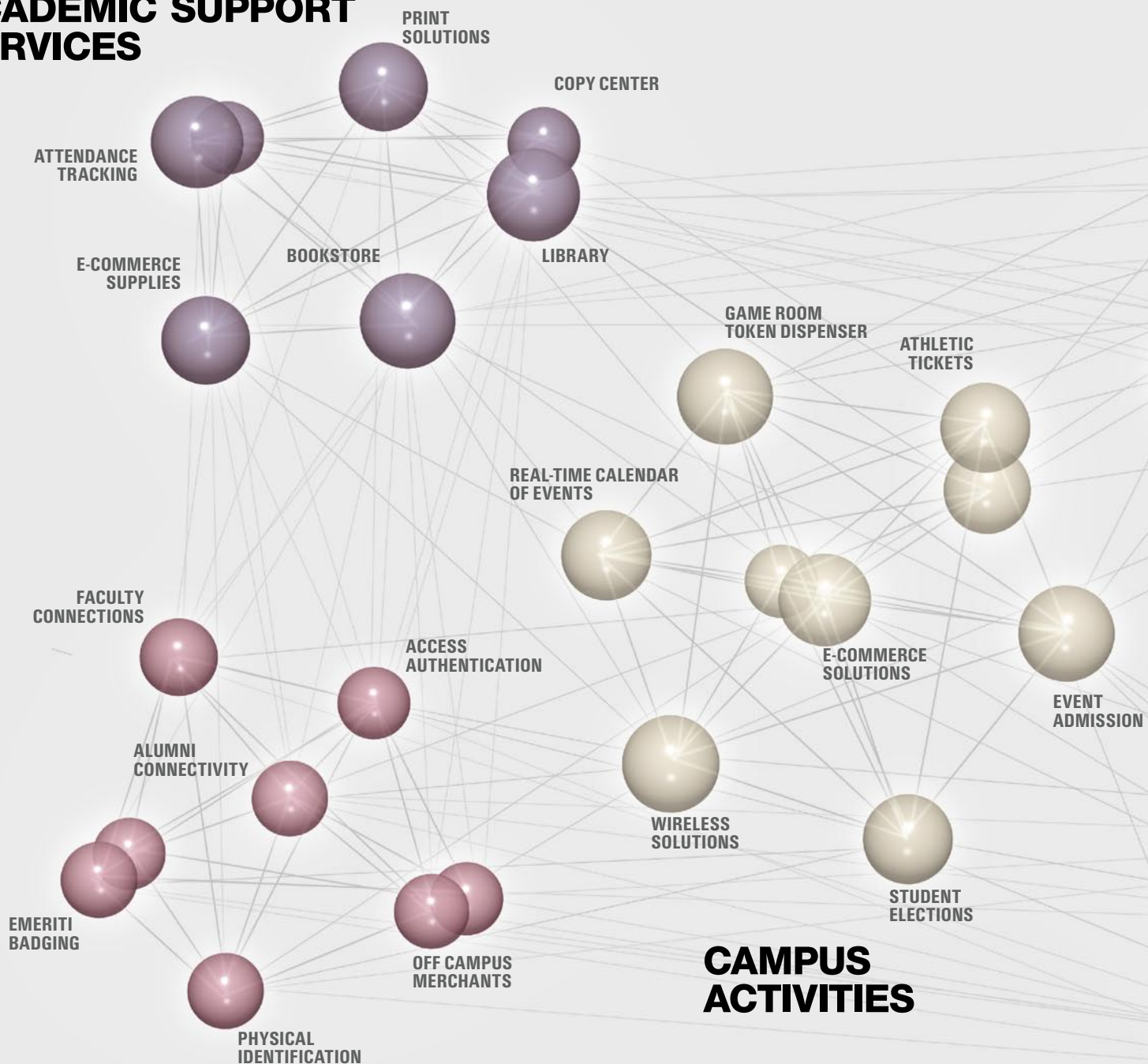

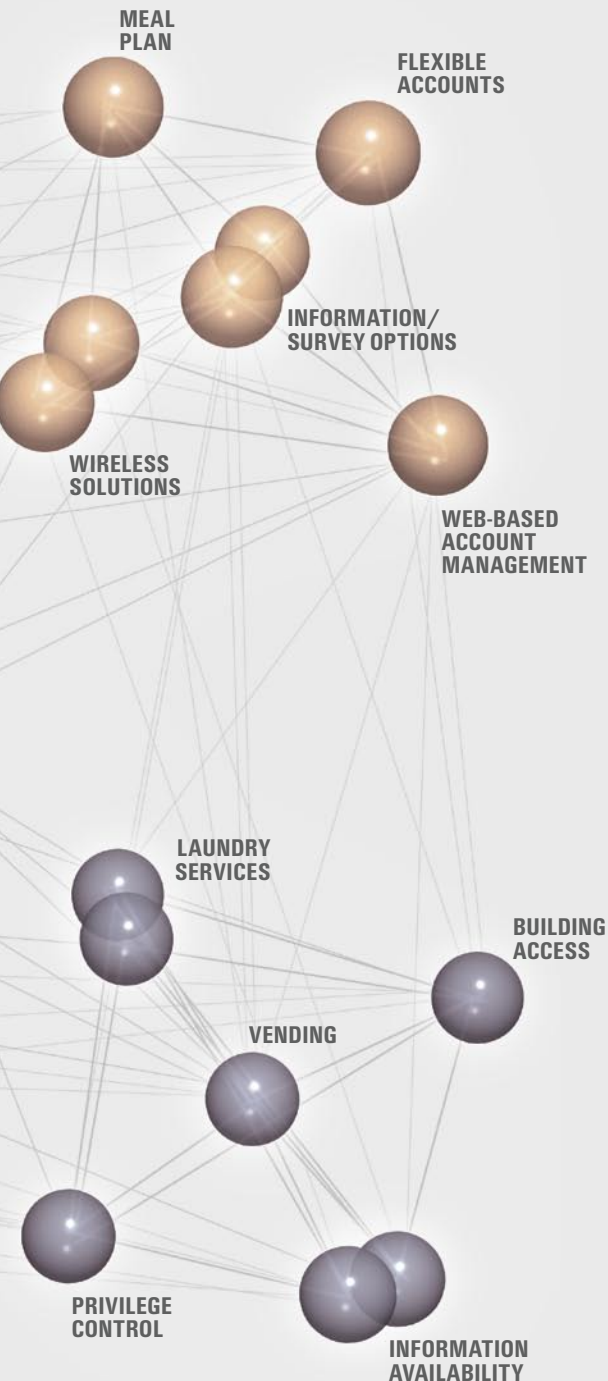

Students check out books, use printers and copiers, dine both on and off campus, buy vended products, access online databases, vote in elections, attend rallies, participate in intramural sports and require service from a multitude of campus departments. All are facilitated through the Blackboard Commerce Suite to the great benefit of both the institution and the student.

Increased Revenue

Clemson University extended its Tiger 1 Card program to include off campus merchants in October 2004, increasing revenues as well as student satisfaction. According to Steve Robbins, Director of Information Technology Services for the Division of Student Affairs, "Clemson University is pleased to utilize the BbOne program to expand acceptance of the Tiger 1 Card to off campus merchants. We are impressed with the performance of our off campus program to date. During the first full month of the program, off campus sales led to a 26% increase in overall sales as compared to the previous 3 year average. Business Efficiency and Student Satisfaction

As a large community college, Sinclair was challenged with an outdated Identification Card system that led to the creation of multiple cards for each student with no common service platform. The President of the University and Board of Trustees mandated the creation of a new card offering multiple service opportunities on a common platform that would pay for itself within five years. Sinclair's Director of Business Services, Charlie Giles, worked with a campus task force to accomplish this directive. According to Mr. Giles, "The project has been highly successful....78,000 cards have been issued and millions of campus transactions have been processed." In addition, the University has saved over \$150,000 per year in labor costs.

Video Imaging / Card Production enables production of the campus ID card used to access campus services. Integrated through Blackboard Building Blocks®, the DataCard® system creates a database that can be used in multiple locations by multiple users.



Facilities / Door Access Administration provides controlled access to sensitive locations based on a variety of parameters, such as time, date and cardholder privileges.



Event / Activity Access Administration enables improved authorization and registration of attendance for special or regularly scheduled activities. Institutions can authorize access, record attendance and ensure accurate administration through permanent as well as wireless readers.

Settlement, Recruitment and Support

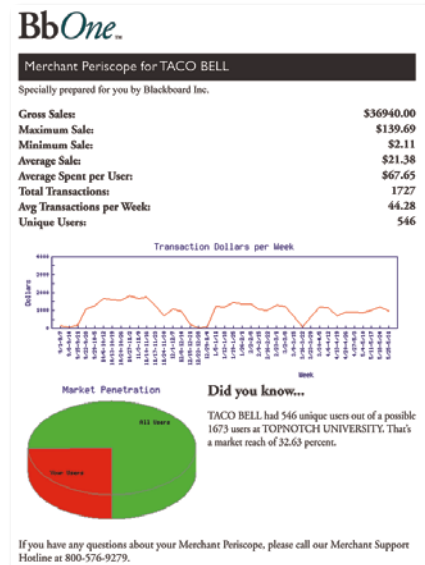

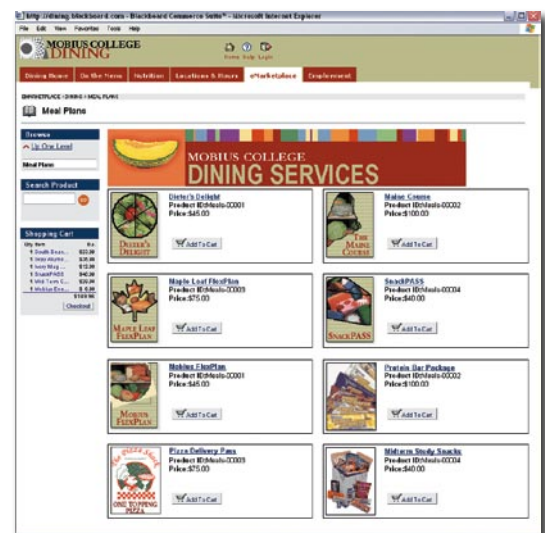

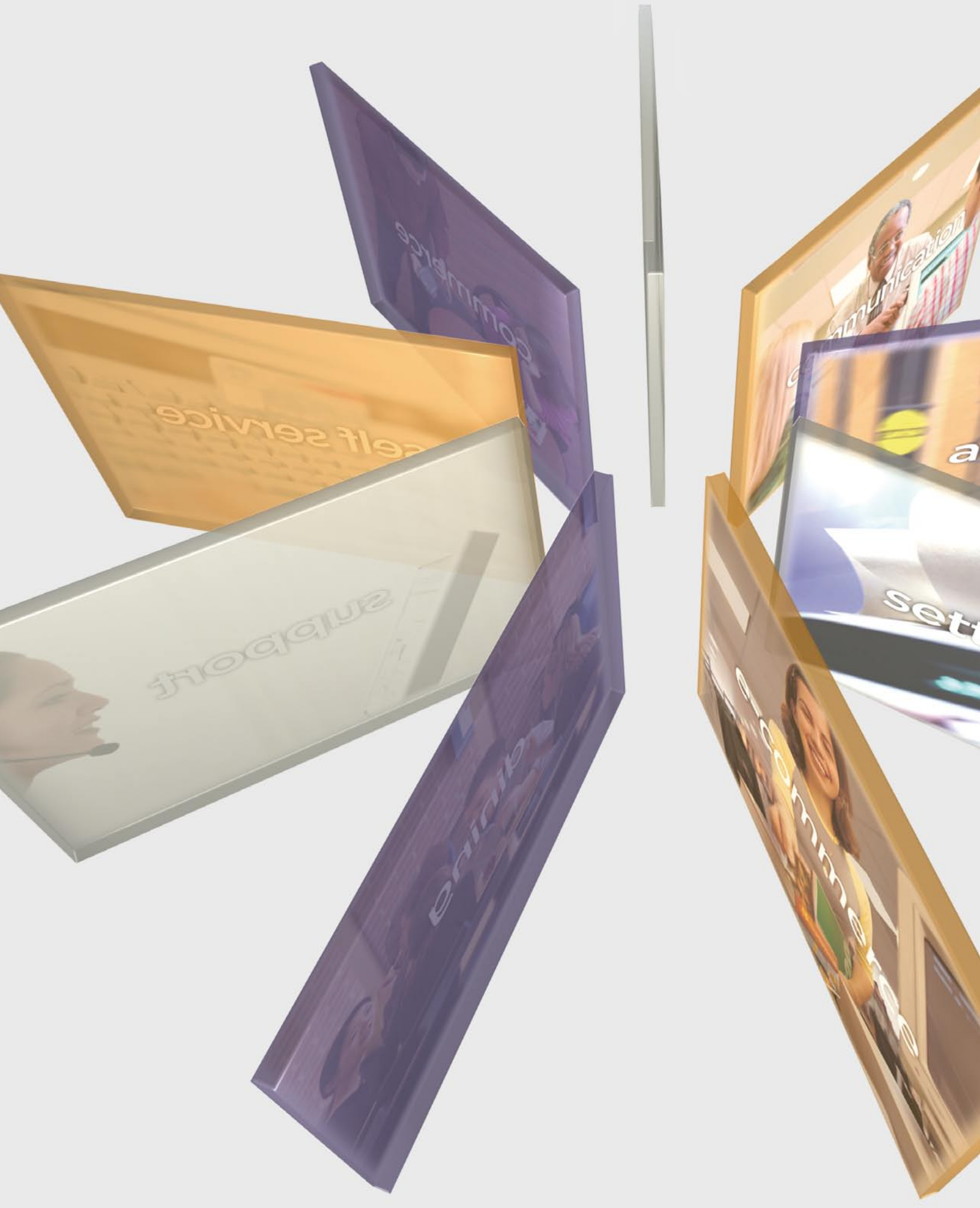
